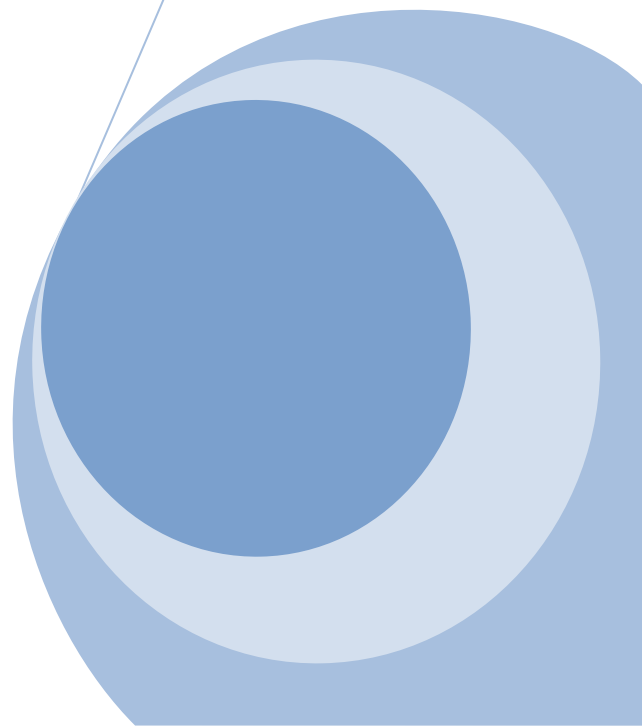
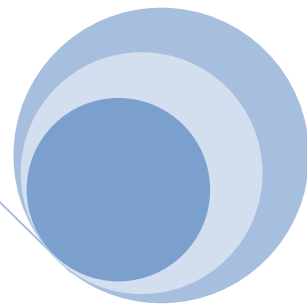
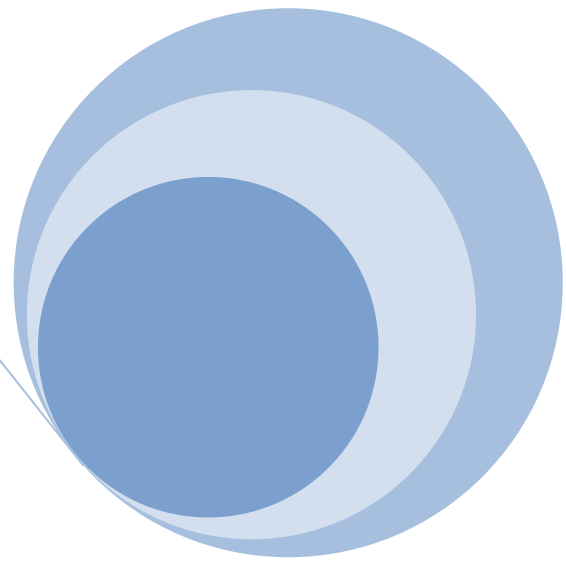

●●●Incineration Plant (ペットの火葬と死犬などの回収)

Incineration Plant (Seisou Center) (Tel. 372-1646, Tax. 372-1406)

The Incineration Plant (Seisou Center) accepts dead bodies of dogs, cats or other animals for cremation in a special incinerator.

(1) Place	Incineration Center (Misono-cho 3688, Tel. 372-1646)
(2) Reception time	Every Monday – Saturday, 9:00-12:00 and 13:00-16:00
(3) Fees	1,520 yen for a dog 1,010 yen for a cat
(4) Others	Attendance or collecting ash is not allowed.

●Notes in carrying the body

Put it in a cardboard box or a bag to make it easy to carry. In doing so, please do not include incombustibles such as collars. Other things of remembrance can be included if they are combustible.

When a pet dog is dead, you need to submit a report of death and to return the dog license. Please return it to the Environmental Policy Division (*Kankyō Seisaku Ka*) in the fourth floor of the main building of the municipal office, or to animal clinics in the city.

●●●Incineration Plant (犬,猫の避妊手術の助成)

Environmental Policy Division (*Kankyou Seisaku Ka*) (Tel. 059 382-9014)

The municipal office subsidizes a portion of the costs of contraception surgeries for dogs and cats.

●●●Registration of Dogs (犬の登録)

Environmental Policy Division (*Kankyou Seisaku Ka*) (Tel. 059 382-9014)

Dogs of 91 days or more after birth must be registered at the Environmental Policy Division (*Kankyou Seisaku Ka*) or animal clinics in the city. Dogs that are already registered after the modification of the registration system in April, Heisei 7 (2005) do not need to be newly registered.

The registration fee (once in a lifetime): 3,000 yen

*Please report to the Environmental Policy Division (*Kankyou Seisaku Ka*) in occasions a dog is dead or you inherited one from others. Also when the place where dog is kept has changed by a move out of the keeper, please report to the destination municipality.

●●●Proper manners in keeping pets (ペットの飼い方)

Keep a good manner in keeping pets not to annoy your neighbors.

- It is dangerous to let pets loose. Keep them with codes.
- Take proper care of dog deposit.
- Keep pets from unnecessary barking to avoid annoying the people around.
- Keep the place you keep your pets clean.
- Have them receive contraceptive surgery if you would not want breeding.
- Take care of them to the last with full responsibility.

●●●Vaccination of Hydrophobia (Rabid dog disease) (狂犬病予防注射)

Environmental Policy Division (*Kankyou Seisaku Ka*) (Tel. 059 382-9014)

A vaccination for hydrophobia (mad dog disease) prevention is an obligation for dogs of 91 days or more after birth.

Please make the registration at the Environmental Policy Division (*Kankyou Seisaku Ka*) or animal clinics in Suzuka city.

- 1) Fees for hydrophobia prevention (every year) 2,650 yen
 - 2) Fees for the issuance of vaccination certificate 550 yen
- 3,200 yen in total
