

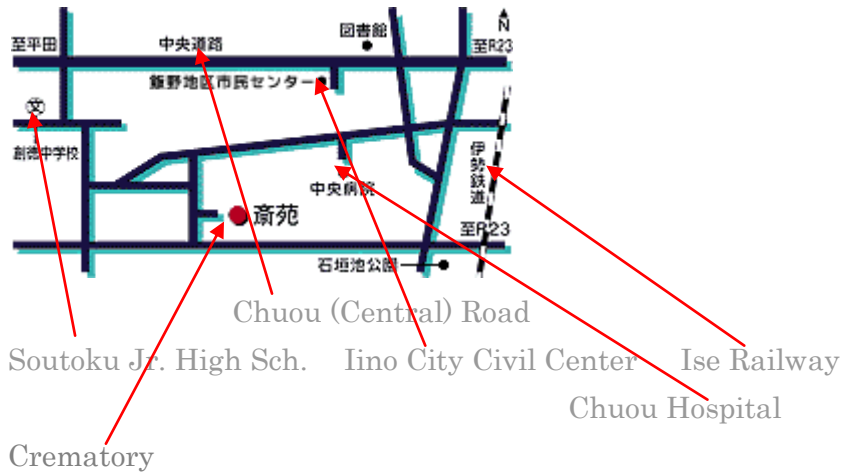

The Suzuka City Funeral Hall has 6 cremation furnaces, a parting room, 4 waiting rooms, and a funeral hall.

■ Closed	January first, the 15th of each month
■ Fees	Cremation Adult: 4 thousand yen (50 thousand yen for non-citizens) Child: 3 thousand yen (40 thousand yen for non-citizens) Funeral hall: 3 hours, 21 thousand yen (52 thousand yen for non-citizens)
■ Parking	Accommodates 2 buses, 78 cars



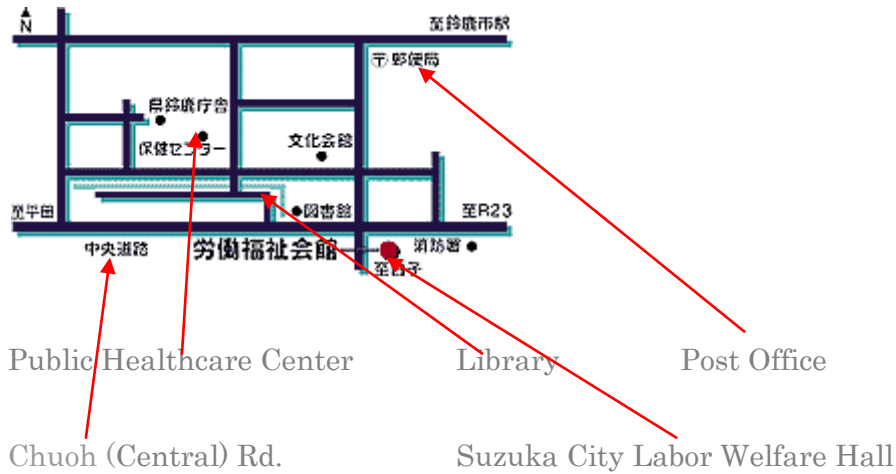
●●● Suzuka City Labor Welfare Hall (労働福祉会館)

The Suzuka City Labor Welfare Hall was established in 1975 (*Showa* 50) for promotion worker's welfare. The Hall has a large conference hall that accommodates 300 persons, a middle-sized hall that accommodates 85 persons; the offices of two labor-related groups are located including Suzuka Labor Welfare Council.

Registrations for circle activities are accepted at any time.</p> <p>Note: <i>Monthly Bulletin Suzuka</i> is issued only in Japanese, simple Japanese, Portuguese, and Spanish as of October 2009.</p> <p>【Child raising support】 The child raising support project held at the center is open for children before enrollment and their custodians. For inquiries regarding the child raising support project, please call the Child Care Division (<i>Kosodate Shien Ka</i>; Phone: 059 382-7661). With a registration beforehand, some of the facilities such as play room are open for use from 9:30 to 16:30.</p>

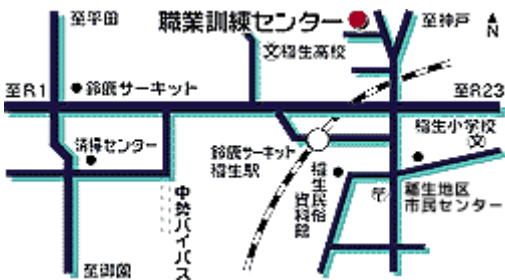
●●● Suzuka Vocational Training Center (鈴鹿地域職業訓練センター)

Suzuka Vocational Training Center was established for vocational training in 1984 (*Showa* 54). The center is equipped with an assembly room that accommodates 300 persons, laboratory that accommodates 45 persons. Those rooms are open for use for meetings, training, or exhibitions. The center also runs training course for individuals, of typing/PC, customer services, etc.
