

How to SORT AND DISPOSE OF HOUSEHOLD WASTE

- Put your waste out at the designated collection point by 8 a.m. on the collection day.
- **Do not put out your waste on days other than the collection day.**
- Do not double bag any items other than food scraps and sanitary products.
- Each bag should weigh less than 5 kg (up to 5 bags per collection).
- An item that weighs 5 kg or more or that does not fit into a designated garbage bag is classified as large-sized waste. Do not put such waste at the collection point.

Information on waste sorting can be found through your computer/smartphone.

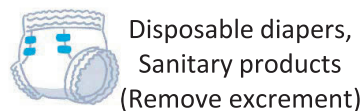

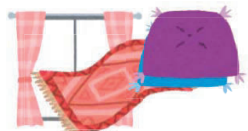
(Green garbage bags designated by Suzuka City)

Be sure to remove residues from plastic waste.

- Once clean, dispose of as **plastic waste**.
- If it cannot be cleaned, dispose of as **combustible waste**.



Plastic waste

(Pink garbage bags designated by Suzuka City)



- This applies to plastic containers and packaging.

- A PET (plastic) bottle itself is classified as **recyclable waste B** or **non-combustible waste**.

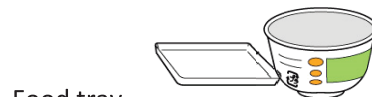

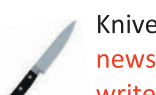

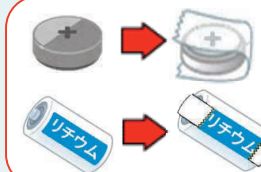
Spray cans, Gas cartridge



Be sure to use up all the contents. Do not make any holes in them. Put only spray cans and gas cartridges in a clear, colorless bag separate from other "**non-recyclable waste**," "rechargeable batteries, etc."

Rechargeable batteries, etc.

- Button battery, Coin battery
- Rechargeable battery (Lithium-ion battery, NiCad battery, Nickel-metal hydride battery)

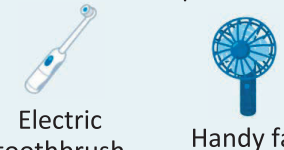

- Items with rechargeable batteries that cannot be removed



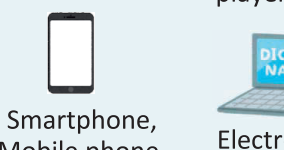

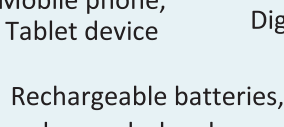

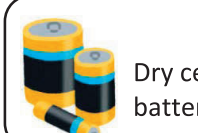

Cartons

- Tie each item together with string.
- Cartons should be washed, dried, and cut open. Cartons with aluminum interiors and plastic spouts are classified as **combustible waste**.

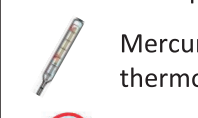

- "Dry-cell batteries" and "other hazardous waste (fluorescent tubes, mirrors, mercury thermometers)" should be disposed of separately in clear, colorless bags.

If there is no collection point for recyclable waste, recyclable waste A and clothes should be disposed of as **combustible waste**. Cans, PET (plastic) bottles, and glass bottles are classified as **non-combustible waste**.

Recyclable waste B

PET (plastic) bottles



- Rinse cans and PET (plastic) bottles and put them separately in containers at the collection point.
- Do not crush cans when disposing of them.
- Crush PET (plastic) bottles when disposing of them.

Other colors

- Rinse glass bottles and put them in baskets placed at the collection point, separating them into three colors.
- Crown caps, caps, stoppers, etc., of glass bottles are **non-combustible waste**. (Those with the plastic mark are **plastic waste**.)

Clothes



- Put them in a clear, colorless bag and tie the bag.
- Dirty items, underwear, socks, pillows, sheets, carpets, down jackets, and stuffed toys are classified as **combustible waste**.

Large-sized waste

(Items that do not fit into designated garbage bags or weigh 5 kg or more.)

- How to apply
 1. Call the Suzuka City Large-sized Waste Reception Center.
※ One large-sized waste disposal ticket (200 yen) is required per item.
 2. Attach the large-sized waste disposal ticket in a visible place in a way that it does not come off.
 3. Put the waste at your front door (or on the first floor if you live in an apartment or condominium) by 8 a.m. on the collection day.

(Remove the contents.)

Dispose of it using either method ① or ②.

- ① Drop it off directly at the **Non-combustible Waste Recycling Center**.
- ② Ask for collection at the computer manufacturer's reception desk.

Be sure to delete all data, including personal information.

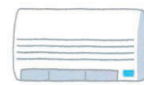

※ Depending on the collection site, staff may collect the item in person, so please let us know.

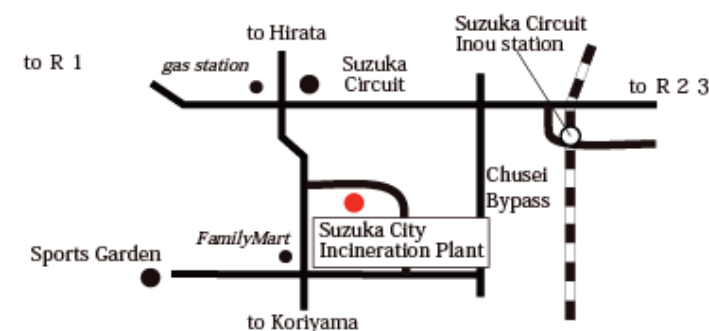
